Dear Superintendent Barley,

Thank you for submitting a COVID-19 Safety Plan (CSP) to conduct in-person instruction. Our panel has completed a review of the plan and is in agreement that there are no deficiencies that would delay the reopening of in-person instruction.

**Schools may not reopen for grades 7-12 if the county remains in Purple Tier.** As a reminder, consistent with the July 17 Framework, schools may reopen at all grades if they are located in counties in the Red, Orange or Yellow Tiers under the Blueprint for a Safer Economy. As long as Sacramento County remains in the Purple Tier, only elementary school (grades TK-6) will be able to return for in-person learning.

At this time we are highly encouraging school sites to schedule school site visits with Sacramento County Public Health. Sacramento County Public Health school team serves as an advisory resource. School site visits are not a formal or informal endorsement, but rather an educational opportunity to continue to provide recommendations on how to mitigate the risks of COVID-19 spread.
