As part of our upper elementary curriculum the students were asked to develop a Student Activist Project.

The purpose of the projects is to promote social awareness, identify real world problems and problem solving skills. Students are encouraged to identify a meaningful way in which to promote a cause, support an organization, and/or bring about awareness and change for a cause they support.

The children's passion and desire to

help and effect change in their larger community, both humbles and inspires me. We have had students organize book drives, knit hats for babies in the NICU, create warm blankets for those fighting cancer, collect and organize safety gear to be used for carline, and even spearhead a petition that led to the installation of a turn lane in front of the Bradshaw site, to name just a few.

Earlier this week, as part of his project, Jadon A organized a school-wide assembly that was held on Wednesday, May 30th. Presenting at the

assembly was a special guest speaker from Republic Services. She discussed what a landfill is, how long it takes to break down recyclable materials, what materials you can recycle, and the importance of recycling to our environment, and how it decreases our carbon footprint.

It is these kinds of activities, promoting the initiative of our young people that promote global awareness and independence; both key principles of our Montessori philosophy.
