Documents Needed to Drive on Field Trips:

- Department of Justice Live Scan Clearance (only needed once)
- Current Clear TB test (Good for 4 years)
- 7 Habits of Highly Effective Volunteers Class (only needed once)
- A current certified 10-year H6 DMV report of your driving record (needed once)
- K-4 – DMV 3 Year Driver History Report: due in subsequent years after submitting Form H-6 the first time, or upon request. This report has a mail order request form. Please note that a 10-year H6 DMV report can **ONLY** be obtained by making a DMV appointment/walk-in and we cannot accept a DMV printout older than 30 days old.)
- Current CA Driver's License
- Current Car Registration (needed yearly)
- Current Car Insurance Declaration Page - verifying \$100,000/\$300,000 coverage (needed each time policy is renewed)
