Parent Engagement: LCAP Meeting

April 13, 2018
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In July 2013, Governor Brown signed a new school funding model into law. This new model is known as the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF). The LCFF requires school districts to develop a plan at the local level known as the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) that guides priorities in the development of the school's budget. The LCAP is built around eight priority areas identified by the California Department of Education (CDE):

- Access to core services
- Implementation of Common Core State Standards
- Access to a broad course of study
- Student achievement

- Student engagement
- Parent involvement
- School climate

The LCAP is a three-year plan that describes the goals, actions, services, and expenditures to support positive student outcomes that address the state and local priorities.

The LCAP is an opportunity for local educational agencies such as CMP to share their stories of how, what, and why programs and services are selected to meet their local needs. Input from all stakeholders is used to create the LCAP. Executive Director Gary Bowman will be visiting the Elk Grove Bradshaw campus on Tuesday, April 17th to meet

with parents, children, and staff and gather input for developing the LCAP.
